RE: Regulate Electricity cost to only reflect CPI rises.

I know that it is my duty to keep you informed of my will on anything that comes before Parliament, or that should come before Parliament.

IT IS MY WILL that you take immediate and ongoing action to ensure that with respect to any aspects associated with the cost of Electricity to the people of Qld, we have had already 15.8% increase over the last two years:

1. the rights of the people granted in the Australian Constitution sections 108,109 and 117 are maintained;
2. the Qld Government re- regulate the Electricity industry in Qld to reflect the will of the people and only increase with CPI, as to reflect wages EBA increases and the cost of living.
3. the Qld Government act on this as so the people of Qld are not discriminated under the provisions the Australian Constitution sections 108,109 and 117.
4. you determine the will of the people with respect to other states and section 117 of the Australian Constitution that only reflect the will of the people.
5. you allow your party parliamentarian colleagues to be allowed to fulfil their judicially defined legal function and duty in their Houses of Parliament and to speak and vote absolutely freely according to their individual conscience and to reflect the will of the people they represent.

Further it is MY WILL that by prompt return correspondence you:

1. inform me of any proposal to increase the cost of Electricity cost for the people of QLD that is contrary to powers and rights set out in the Australian Constitution 108,109 and 117, and also regulate the Electricity industry; and
2. inform me of the results of your actions to ensure the states and the people will only incur CPI increases to Electricity in the state of Qld and under the provisions the Australian Constitution section 117.
