

Notice of Time Periods
DBCT Management's 2010 Draft Access Undertaking

On 19 March 2010, the Authority received from DBCT Management Pty Ltd (DBCT Management) an application to approve a draft access undertaking (2010 DAU) to replace the existing access undertaking that expires on 31 December 2010.

On 23 March 2010, stakeholders were requested to lodge submissions by 29 April 2010.

Time periods

In accordance with s147A of the *Queensland Competition Authority Act 1997* (the QCA Act), the Authority must endeavour to decide whether to approve a DAU within six months from the last day of the time for making submissions stated in the investigation notice.

The six-month period does not include any of the following periods:

- (a) a day in the period given by the Authority for making submissions in relation to a DAU or a related document;
- (b) a day in the period where a person has been required to give information or produce a document in response to a notice given by the Authority under s185 of the QCA Act; and
- (c) day(s) agreed to, by the owner or operator of the service or the responsible person, as not being included in the six-month period

Six-month period for DBCT Management's 2010 DAU

In accordance with s147A(4) of the QCA Act, the Authority states the following time periods for DBCT Management's 2010 DAU:

- (a) the six-month period commenced on 23 March 2010; and
- (b) the six-month period ends on 2 November 2010.

The six-month period does not include the following days:

On 23 September 2010, the Authority approved DBCT Management's 2010 Draft Access Undertaking.
