Regulatory Framework

Risks

- A price cap is acceptable this time although last time a revenue cap was in place.
- Forecast revenue for 2007-11 was only \$19,000 out, which meant previous estimates were accurate.

Pricing Framework

• The two part tariff structure was supported.

Renewals Expenditure

• A HUF of 0% for medium priority customers was supported.

SunWater Consultation

 A greater degree of consultation with SunWater is supported, but it is noted that Bowen Broken WSS is a small scheme and does not currently warrant excessive and costly consultation.

Operating Expenditure

Non-direct costs

The quantum of non-direct costs seemed expensive.

Prices

Bulk Scheme

 QCA had done a competent job and the recommended draft prices were broadly supported.

Impact of Recommended Prices

• Sought an outcome where the area / scheme be developed further as an irrigation area. However, there was recognition that cost of land and water in the Burdekin makes the Burdekin a comparatively attractive proposition for growing sugarcane.
