

Preferred Aquaculture Areas displayed are:

- within 5km of a seawater source
- below 10m elevation
- above tidal influence
- slope less than 5%
- freehold, leasehold or state land tenures
- outside areas of MSES
- "rural" zoned

However, these areas are subject to further analysis such as soil characteristics, access to water, water quality of intake and discharge receiving waters, surrounding land uses, flooding, etc.

NOTE: much of the preferred area lies within a flood hazard area.

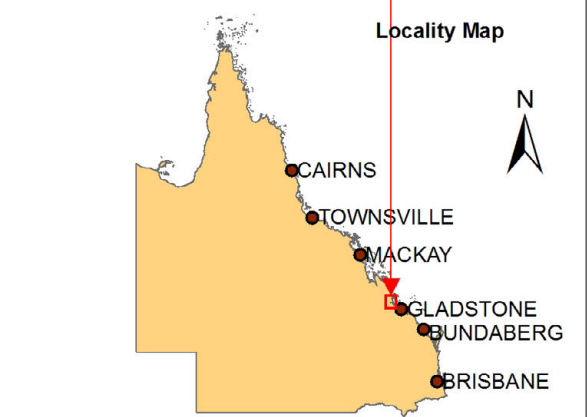
