SUBMISSION ON QCA INTERIM CONSULTATION PAPER ON REGULATED ELECTRICITY PRICES 2017-18

Retail costs

The process now may need to take account of the diversity since 1 July 2016 in retailer standing and other offers, especially differences in the daily charge relative to the kWh charge. These differences may mean that the calculation of the average used in 2015-16 needs to be changed.

Other issues

Calculation of differentials between SEQ standing offers and market contracts should take account of the extent to which any, or all, standing offers may be above the efficient cost of supply.
