No irrigators attended the consultation meeting.

- The notice of meeting did not provide sufficient time for them to attend the consultation.
- A request was made for the irrigators to provide contact details to the Authority so that a
 telephone conference be held to receive the details presented at meetings and to answer
 questions. If warranted a special visit would be appreciated.

Technical Issues

Scheme Specific Issues

 The WSS is a major supplier to mines, towns, the power station and to a lesser extent irrigators. The WSS capacity is approx 112000ML of which around 3000ML is for irrigation.
