## **Technical Issues**

• Little rationale for pricing greater than water harvesting charges

• Uncertain as to rationale associated with indexing prices according to CPI.

## **Scheme Specific Issues**

- Scheme has a history of comparatively high reliability characterised by wide, deep river access above the weir. Due to recent significant inflow events, weir has been over-topping for several months.
- Other entitlement holders include the local government authority (Paroo Shire Council) and the golf course.
- Scheme provides benefits to the broader community through the established picnic area and opportunities for angling.
- Local environmental group supports the introduction of a fish ladder.
