Process Issues

• more notice of meetings required;

• concerns that QCA would not have access to all SunWater information relevant to pricing.

Technical Issues

- cost allocation: need to review SunWater cost drivers and allocation of costs to recreational users;
- SunWater management and administration costs: concern about the level and allocation of these costs:
- indexation of prices: CPI indexation used in past. Questions arose about future indexation rates;
- water reliability: impact of difference between notional and actual water allocations and need to review guidelines for water allocation;
- tariffs and pricing: prefer uniform pricing across the scheme;
- capacity to pay: difficult to measure and define.

Scheme Specific Issues

• other issues: need to take account of the higher costs to irrigators of pumping water from an aquifer (bore) rather than from a stream or irrigation channel.
