Review Event Submission - Central Queensland Flooding 2015

Dear Catherine.

Please find enclosed Aurizon Network's submission to the Queensland Competition Authority (QCA) on the proposed cost recovery mechanism and resulting tariff impacts, which are necessary for Aurizon Network to allow cost recovery of incremental maintenance cost for the Moura system flood repair works following the February 2015 floods.

Aurizon Network is seeking to claim incremental maintenance costs incurred as a direct result of the flood rectification work through the provisions set out in Aurizon Network's 2010 Access Undertaking, specifically clause 2.2.7 of Schedule F, Part A, in the form of a Review Event.

This claim relates to only the incremental maintenance expenditure of \$4,237,120 expressed FY2016 dollars incurred in the Moura system.

Detailed calculations supporting the cost recovery options and tariff impacts have been provided in soft copy form. Consistent with past submissions, Aurizon Network requests that the supporting models are not published as they contain confidential customer tonnage information.

Input assumptions and tariff impacts are subject to change as part of the finalisation of the 2014 Draft Amending Access Undertaking.
