FY2022 Endorsed Variation Event - Queensland Competition Authority Regulatory Fees 2021-22

I am writing to inform the Queensland Competition Authority (**QCA**) of an Endorsed Variation Event. Aurizon Network has received the following notifications from the QCA:

- 25 June 2021 The QCA's Regulatory Fee estimate for FY2022; and
- 30 June 2021 A cost update on its FY2021 Regulatory Fees was received (QCA Notifications)

Both notifications constitute an endorsed variation in accordance with Schedule F, Clause 5.2 (c) of the 2017 Access Undertaking (UT5). Aurizon Network is seeking approval to reflect this in Allowable Revenues and Reference tariffs for Financial Year 2022 (FY2022).

Regulatory Requirement for an Endorsed Variation

The UT5 requirements for an Endorsed Variation in Schedule F, clause 5.4, outline that Aurizon Network must:

- Nominate the Reference Tariff to be varied:
- Include evidence that the Endorsed Variation Event has occurred; and
- Include details of the methodology, data and assumptions used to vary the Reference Tariff.

In accordance with clause UT5, a Reference Tariff variation must be submitted within 60 days of receiving a notice that constitutes an Endorsed Variation Event.

Methodology

FY2021 QCA Levy

The notification dated 30 June 2021 identified the FY2021 fees to be \$684,000 (excluding GST) subject to the final audit and QCA board approval. This results in an over-recovery by the QCA as the original FY2021 estimate was \$746,000 excl GST.

FY2022 Proposed QCA Levy

The 25 June 2021 notification outlined the QCA FY2022 Regulatory Fee estimate to be \$581,665 excl GST.

On the 22 June 2021 the QCA approved the FY2022 Annual Review of Reference Tariffs which included recovery of the Regulatory Fee through the QCA Levy of \$0.00327/NT (current QCA Levy). This was approved as there was no more current information on the QCA Regulatory Fees in Aurizon Network's possession at the time of that approval.



Taking into account the timing of this Endorsed Variation, Aurizon Network is proposing that the current QCA Levy remain for both July and August 2021. Effective from 1 September 2021, Aurizon Network proposes a QCA Levy of \$0.001194/NT, which takes into account both of the QCA Notifications.

The methodology for calculating the QCA Levy for FY2022 is set out below:
