Regulatory Asset Base Roll-Forward 2014-15

I am pleased to submit the Regulatory Asset Base Roll-forward Report (RAB Roll-forward) incorporating the approved capital expenditure amounts for the 2014-15 year as required under clause 9.3.2 of the 2010 Access Undertaking (2010AU).

The 2014-15 RAB Roll-forward reflects the Queensland Competition Authority's (QCA's) 12 May 2016 final decision to approve the \$614.3m claimed by Aurizon Network in the 2014-15 Capital Expenditure Report¹. The 2014-15 RAB Roll-forward is submitted under an extension request approved by the Queensland QCA².

The majority of the 2014-15 claim reflects \$457.5m relating to Wiggins Island Rail Project (WIRP). This is only a partial claim of the WIRP total project costs, consisting of project segments commissioned in 2014-15. Consistent with the QCA's Final Decision (FD) on Aurizon Network's 2014 Draft Access Undertaking (UT4), WIRP capital included in the 2014-15 RAB Roll-forward has been deferred for pricing purposes for the 2014-15 year. Of the 2014-15 WIRP claim, 94% of costs have been allocated to the WIRP system while 6% allocated to existing Blackwater and Rolleston users in line with the FD system allocations.

Incorporating the WIRP capital into the RAB via this submission has no implication on UT4 tariffs, as tariffs are based off the WIRP capital indicator. Any variances between the indicator and the timings of capex claims will be dealt with as part of capital carryover mechanism.

The 2014-15 RAB Roll-forward reflects a WACC of 7.17%, actual inflation of 1.51% and depreciation methodology consistent with FD.

Further, as part of this submission Aurizon Network aims to finalise the 2013-14 RAB Roll-forward, which is the starting point for the 2014-15 RAB Roll-forward. Aurizon Network's 2013-14 Roll-forward submission did not cap asset lives for GAPE assets at 20 years, as a consequence regulatory depreciation of the RAB was understated. To be consistent with the FD, Aurizon Network has amended the 2013-14 Roll-forward for this oversight. This however is a presentation issue and has no implications on UT4 tariffs as the 20 year cap was applied correctly for pricing purposes. Aurizon Network has discussed this amendment with the QCA's UT4 modelling team.

A summary of the 2014-15 RAB Roll-forward is provided in Attachment A. Detailed calculations supporting the RAB Roll-forward have been provided in soft copy form. Consistent with past submissions, Aurizon Network requests that the supporting models are not published.

There was no value attributable to the disposals or transfer of assets relevant RAB for the 2014-15 year. A summary of assets disposed is included in Attachment B.

In accordance with 2010AU clause 9.6(c), the 2014-15 RAB Roll-forward report is accompanied by signed Responsibility Statements from both the Aurizon Network Chief Executive Officer and one Independent Director of Aurizon Network.

Approval: Aurizon Network's 2014-15 capital expenditure claim

On 11 May 2016, we approved Aurizon Network's revised 2014–15 capital expenditure claim for \$614.3 million to be included in the regulatory asset base (RAB), in accordance with Schedule A of the 2010 Access Undertaking. The breakdown of the approved claim is provided in Table 1 to this letter.

As you would be aware, we engaged CMT Solutions (CMT) to undertake an engineering assessment of the claim for \$614.6 million (inclusive of interest during construction) submitted in October 2015.

Overall, we found the claim to be prudent with the exception of \$0.3 million relating to axle counter replacements that are to be deferred until commissioning.

We will be publishing a copy of this letter on our website.

Treatment of 2014-15 Regulatory Asset Base Roll-forward as part of UT4 finalisation

I refer to Aurizon Network's request of 30 May 2016 for an extension of time for its 2014–15 RAB Roll-forward, and for this to be included as part of its submission of an Undertaking in response to the Queensland Competition Authority's (QCA's) final decision on the 2014 draft access undertaking. In making this request, Aurizon Network noted that an extension would allow the 2013–14 and 2014–15 roll forwards to be finalised at the same time. Further, an extension would not have any adverse impact on stakeholders as it would not influence any pricing outcome.

I am pleased to inform you that I have approved an extension to the 2014–15 RAB roll-forward. However, noting that there is no firm date for the submission of an undertaking, and following consultation between my staff and officers from Aurizon Network, the RAB roll-forward should be submitted to the QCA no later than 30 June 2016.
