NOTICE OF INTENTION TO SELL LAND

This notice is given by Gladstone Regional Council, and relates to properties described below.

Background

This notice is given because rates or charges levied by the Council on the below properties are at least 3 years overdue or default judgment has been granted by the Magistrates Court on vacant or commercial land.
