I write on behalf of Boyne Burnett Inland Rail Inc.

We formed to facilitate development of the rail corridor from Taragoola (near Gladstone, Central Queensland), through the Boyne Valley, on to Monto, Eidsvold, Mundubbera and south through Gayndah as a cycling, bushwalking and horse riding trail.

The Lake Awoonga Recreation Strategy is a positive initiative for the Gladstone community which will promote and enhance economic development through tourism for the wellbeing and benefit of communities in the Gladstone Region.
