Ergon Energy Network's and Energex's submission to the Queensland Competition Authority's Regulated Retail Electricity Prices in Regional Queensland for 2026-27 – Draft Determination

Ergon Energy Corporation Limited (Ergon Energy Network) and Energex Limited (Energex), both distribution network service providers (DNSPs) operating in Queensland, welcome the opportunity to provide comment to the Queensland Competition Authority (QCA) on its Regulated Retail Electricity Prices in Regional Queensland for 2026-27 Draft Determination.

Our feedback is focused on the terms and conditions for large customers to access retail tariffs with interruptible supply. We support the QCA's proposed amendment to the retail tariff schedule to enable tariffs 60A and 60B to be offered to large customers in circumstances that could be permitted by future network tariff arrangements, rather than solely where standard load control signalling is available. To give effect to these arrangements, further amendments and implementation activities will be required over time, including updates to network systems and the development and rollout of appropriate customer-side equipment. We will continue to work closely with stakeholders to progress these changes and ensure they are clearly communicated as the framework evolves.
