

Estimating your annual bill

About this bill estimator

Your next annual bill will be estimated if you enter your expected electricity usage below, including any solar energy you export. You will also see how much that bill could differ from your previous annual bill.

The bill estimates are based on the regulated electricity prices in regional Queensland for the most common small customer tariffs and the solar feed-in tariff for 2025-26 and 2026-27.

How to estimate your bill

Enter your expected annual usage and solar exports in the light blue boxes (in kilowatt hours).

You can use your actual usage/export from the past 12 months or your estimate for 2026-27 (for help, refer to Ergon Energy's [guide to reading your electricity bill](#)).

If you do not have a secondary controlled load tariff or a solar PV system, leave these boxes empty.
